

OBJECTIVES

The School of Graduate Studies at Midwestern Baptist College is designed to provide study beyond the Bachelor's Degree leading to a Master's degree or Doctor's degree in Religious Education.

These programs are designed to equip the student to teach at the college level or to serve in an administrative capacity. However, a further, crucial objective is for the student to develop the knowledge and intellectual skills for advanced inquiry and research.

REQUIREMENTS

Graduate level programs require a Bachelor degree, Bible major with Greek for admission.

Life experience in Christian service may apply for up to 8 hours toward the Master's program. Some senior-level courses may be used if approved by the dean, and not needed for the applicant's bachelor degree.

COSTS

Application fee ----- \$20
Registration ----- \$100 (one time)
Tuition ----- \$125/hour

GRADUATE PROGRAMS IN THEOLOGY AND EDUCATION

The Master's degree requires 36 hours in graduate level studies.

- 8 graduate courses (4 hours each)
- Master's Thesis (4 hours credit)
(25,000 words = 75 pages/ds)

POST-GRADUATE PROGRAMS IN THEOLOGY AND EDUCATION

The Doctor's degree requires 64 hours beyond the Master's degree.

- 14 graduate courses (4 hours each)
- Doctoral Discertation (8 hours credit)
(50,000 words = 150 pages/ds)
